A summary of the Luxembourg Guidelines - Terminology Guidelines for the Protection of Children from Sexual Exploitation and Sexual Abuse

Do not say:

★ Child pornography



× Child porn

Child prostitution

Child sex tourism

These terms imply a level of consent. A child can <u>never</u> consent. This is a crime.

Paedophile

This is a specific psychological condition.

Instead, say:

- Child sexual abuse material
- Child sexual abuse
- Child sexual exploitation
- Child sexual exploitation material
- Online child sexual exploitation
- Child sex offender
- Perpetrators of sexual crimes against children
